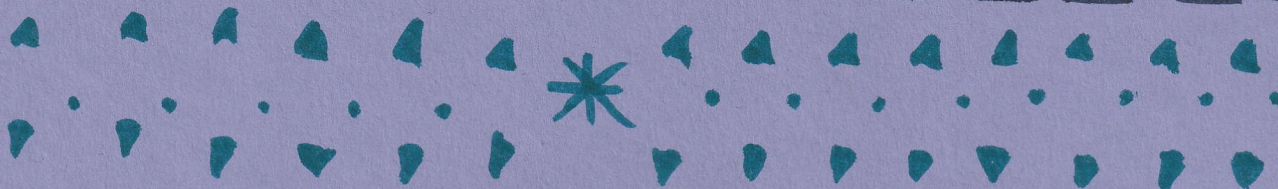
① Number One: Woolacombe Sands

• parking spaces are regularly overloaded during the summer season

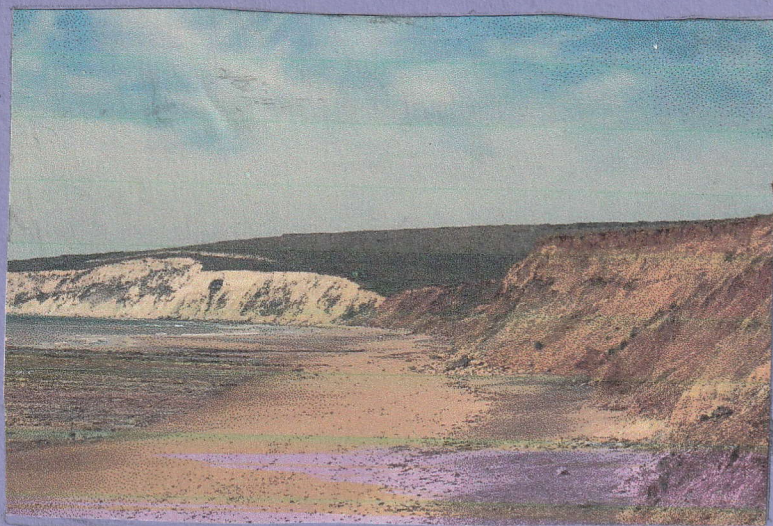
• activities: surfing, jet-skiing, kayaking
